


EVOLUTION OF MONETARY POVERTY IN PERU AS OF 2014


Percetage variation of the Income by Quintiles, 2014 / 2013



20% of population with lower incomes




Percentage variation of the Expense per Quintiles, 2014 / 2013


Population

The average monthly cost, in the year2014, of these calories (food basket) is of S/. 161


Incidence of Monetary Poverty de la Pobreza 4 Monetaria, 2009 – 2014

(Miles)




Incidence of Monetary Poverty by Residence Area, encia, 2009-2014









Incidence of Extreme Monetary Poverty, 2009 - 2014 4 (Thousands)



Incidence of Extreme Monetary Poverty by Residence Area, 2009 - 2014



Poor Households by Household Head, 2011-2014 4 (Percentage)



INCIDENCE OF POVERTY BY NATIVE LANGUAGE, 2014




CATEGORY OF OCUPATION OF POOR EMPLOYED POPULATION, 2014

EDUCATIONAL LEVEL OF POOR POPULATION AGED 15 YEARS OLDS AND OVER, 2014








Population with Access to Water, According to Monetary Poverty Condition, 2011 - 2014 (Percentage)








Population with Electric Lighting, by Monetary Poverty Condition, 2011 - 2014 (Percentage)






Population with Access to Mobile Telephony, by segú Monetary Poverty Condition, 2011-2014 2014 (Percentage)






Population with Access to Cable Television, by Monetary Poverty Condition, 2011 - 2014


